

## EU RoHS - Declaration

Schwäbisch Hall, 17.05.2024

The current **EU RoHS** is based on **Directive 2011/65/EU** of the European Parliament plus the delegated **EU Directive 2015/863**, which added four additional substances (phthalates) to the six previous EU RoHS substances:

- Lead (0.1%)
- Mercury (0.1%)
- Cadmium (0.01%)
- Hexavalent chromium (0.1%)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1%)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1%)
- **Di (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1%)**
- **Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1%)**
- **Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1%)**
- **Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1%)**

Directive EU 2017/2102 brought changes with regard to the extension of exemptions from substance restrictions; the period within which a decision must be made on the extension of an exemption, the duration of exemptions for EU RoHS category 11 (electrical equipment/products that cannot be assigned to any of the other 10 EU RoHS categories and were previously not subject to the EU RoHS scope), and the reuse of spare parts.

According to our current state of knowledge and the information provided by our own suppliers, we hereby declare that our products are currently compliant with the current EU RoHS directives. We provide this information "AS IS" without any express or implied warranties.
